### Prof. Dr. Theodor Baums

J.D., Bonn 1975; LL.D. Bonn, 1980; habilitation, Bonn, 1985; qualification as a taxation lawyer 1978. Assistant professor at the Institute for Business Law, University of Bonn, 1977-1985; professor at the University of Muenster 1986-1987; visiting professor at U.C. Berkeley, 1990-1991, at the University of Vienna, 1992, at Stanford CA, 1995, and at Columbia/New York in 1999. In 1987, he joined the faculty of the School of Law of the University of Osnabrueck/Germany where he has founded the Institute for Business Law in 1992.

He is a member of the advisory board of the German Capital Markets Supervisory Agency (BaFin); advisor on corporate governance issues to the Vorstand of the Deutsche Bundesbank; member of the advisory board of the EC Commission on company law; member of the European Model Company Law Group; member of several advisory boards of private companies, of national and international scientific societies, Fellow of the European Corporate Governance Institute (ECGI) in Brussels, Professeur Associé at the University of Luxembourg and editor of several scientific journals.

Theodor Baums has more than 140 books and articles on corporations, civil and antitrust law. He has been awarded the Order of Merit 1<sup>st</sup> class of the Federal Republic of Germany in 2006 and holds honorary doctorates of the European Business School (Dr. rer. pol. h.c.) and Aarhus University (Dr. jur. h. c.).

### Prof. Stanislaw Soltysinski

Professor Stanisław Sołtysiński (1939) has been teaching civil and commercial law at A. Mickiewicz University, Poznań, until his retirement in 2007. He graduated in 1961 at Poznań Law School. Subsequently, he spent 9 months at LSE, Oxford and Cambridge as a British Council research student (1967) and studied at Columbia University (LLM program) in 1972-73. He was teaching as a recurring visiting professor at Pennsylvania University Law School (Philadelphia) between 1975-1992. He also taught at the College of Europe (Brugge) and has been teaching at Munich Intellectual Property Center (since 2006).

Professor Sołtysiński is a member of Poland's Codification Commission since 1997. He chairs the Subcommittee on Company Law. As chairman of special task force, he co-authored the draft of the Code of Commercial Companies adopted by the Polish Parliament in 2000.

Professor Sołtysiński combines academic activities and legal counseling. He is a founder of “Sołtysiński Kawecki & Szlęzak”, a leading Polish law firm where he now serves as an of counsel.
