The marks obtained for the secondary school – or vocational training – leaver's certificate or the technician's diploma 2. Proficiency in English
FSTC	Bachelor en Sciences de la Vie (Bachelor académique), Filière Médecine	100	<p>The classification is made among candidates who submitted a complete file, acceptable from the administrative point of view. It will be carried out when the application period expires, and will be based on the following criteria:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Subjects tested during the final secondary school examination 2. Marks and averages obtained during this examination 3. Linguistic abilities 4. Post-secondary course <p>The classification will be made by at least three professors or assistant professors from the Life Sciences Research Unit</p>

FDEF	Bachelor en Gestion (Bachelor professionnel)	150	<p>1. An initial selection is based on the examination of an application file for holders of a secondary school leaver's certificate or a technical education certificate.</p> <p>2. For holders of a technician's certificate, administrative and commercial division, the selection is based on the examination of an application file and a written examination.</p> <p>The committee that decides on whether to admit a candidate is composed of at least two instructors – researchers.</p>
FLSHASE	Bachelor en Sciences de l'Education (Bachelor professionnel)	135	<p>1. Hold a Luxembourg or international baccalaureate, or an equivalent diploma.</p> <p>2. Admission examination in July: comprehension test of texts written in the official languages of the programme.</p> <p>3. The candidates must be ranked sufficiently high to be given a place.</p>
FLSHASE	Bachelor en Sciences Sociales et Educatives (Bachelor professionnel)	50	<p>Selection procedure in two steps:</p> <p>1. Examination of the application file. Only applicants whose file has been approved by the examination committee (at least two instructors – researchers and one professional from the socio-educational sector) will be considered in the second round. The applicants will be informed in writing of the result of the examination of their application file.</p> <p>2. Written examination and interview.</p>

A personal letter of motivation from the student that <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - includes his or her full CV - explains how and why s/he wants to study psychology - relates to the structure, content and requirements specific to the degree programme - provides the reasons for enrolling at the University of Luxembourg
