From 1974 to 2006 Klaus R. Kunzmann was Professor at the School of Planning at the Technical University of Dortmund, Germany. Since 1993 and until his retirement he held the Jean Monnet Chair in European Spatial Planning.

Klaus R. Kunzmann is a member of The German Academy for Spatial Planning and Research. He has received a honorary PhD from the University of Newcastle/UK. At present he is 'Honorary Professor' at the Bartlett School of Planning, University College London, London, UK; and at Chung Hua University in Hsinchu, Taiwan.
