Profile:

- The candidate must hold a PhD in Mathematics or a related field and must have a post-doctoral experience of at least five years. Experience in PhD supervision will be an asset.
- The successful candidate should hold a strong research record in a modern field of research in geometry. Examples of research directions are moduli spaces in algebraic and analytic geometry, noncommutative geometry, Poisson geometry, geometric aspects of quantization, higher structures in geometry, and infinite dimensional geometry. But other directions are not excluded.
