Description

French language course for beginners. The objective is the acquisition of basic oral and written skills. Students are involved in speaking, listening, writing and reading communicative activities in individual and/or pair and/or group work.

Learning outcomes

By the end of this course, students should be able to:

- present and describe themselves and others;
- count and tell time
- make appointments and talk about their daily routine and leisure activities;
- ask for or order something in a hotel or restaurant;
- make comparisons and indicate preferences;
- understand simple written texts and briefly summarize them.

Evaluation

- speaking, listening, writing and reading skills shall be evaluated in task based activities
- speaking, listening and writing shall also be evaluated via preparation of interviews and questions/roleplay in classes, and presenting results in class respectively in written form. (e.g. daily routines, introducing oneself, meeting new people)

- listening: key information from listening texts must be understood (Advertisements, tv, etc.).
- reading: key information (or quiz) in a short reading must be detected.
- writing: basic “texts” or sequence of sentences should be summarized;
- Students will be evaluated, in accordance to their active partaking in the course, on their regular homework (which also consists of grammar and/or vocabulary exercises/drills) and on their final presentation and test (both written and spoken).
