by Prof. Dr. Gilles Duranton (Wharton School, University of Pennsylvania)

Abstract

As a wave of new data opens near infinite possibilities for new work on land use, this lecture will take stock with insights and limitation of established theories and the state of the empirical literature. The lecture will cover standard monocentric approaches to land use and their empirical validation. Recent non-monocentric development will also be discussed. The lecture will also examine recent trends of decentralization and recentralization, the effects of land use regulations, and challenges arising from the durability of housing. The lecture will mix abstract theorizing and more empirical work in about equal proportions.

Speaker

Prof. Dr. Gilles Duranton (Dean's Chair in Real Estate Professor) is a Professor of Real Estate at the Wharton School of the University of Pennsylvania.

He is a co-editor of the Journal of Urban Economics, a Research Associate at the National Bureau of Economic Research, a Fellow at the Centre for Economic Policy Research, an Affiliate at the LSE International Growth Centre.
