



Receipt of the initial decision.

Notification of Stage 1 decision no more than four (4) weeks after receipt of appeal.

Within one (1) month of receipt of Stage 1 decision or initial decision.

Notification of Stage 2 decision no more than one (1) month after receipt of appeal.

Submission of appeal to Tribunal within one (1) month of notification of Stage 2 decision.

There is a disagreement with an academic/administrative decision.

Stage 1: Non-contentious appeal submitted to the author of the decision

Non-contentious appeal is admitted.

Non-contentious appeal is upheld, issue resolved to student/applicant's satisfaction.

Student/applicant decides to proceed directly to Stage 2: Appeal to the Dispute Committee.

Non-contentious appeal is not admitted.

Non-contentious appeal is rejected, issue not resolved to student/applicant's satisfaction.

Stage 2: Appeal submitted to the Dispute Committee

Appeal is complete and admissible: Dispute Committee examines the case.

Appeal is not complete, additional documentation is requested and appellant is informed of further steps.

Appeal is not admitted.

Dispute Committee upholds the appeal, issue is resolved to appellant's satisfaction.

Dispute Committee rejects the appeal or issue is not resolved to appellant's satisfaction.

Appeal (*recours en annulation*) before the Administrative Tribunal
