L'Europe face à l'autonomie collective. The Right to Collective Bargaining in EU, Between the CJEU and the ECHR

Prof. Filip Dorssemont, Université Catholique de Louvain, Belgium

Abstract:

The European Social Model is facing crucial challenges to its founding concepts, stressed by a decline of representativity of trade unions and the lack of legal certainty for their action.

In this lecture Professor Dorssemont will illustrate the interactions between the jurisprudence of the CJEU and the ECHR in the field of collective labour law. The aim is to investigate the uncertain path along the affirmation at European level of the right to collective bargaining, confronting it with the founding fundamental freedoms within the European internal market.

Speaker

Filip DORSSEMONT is Professor of Labour Law at the Centre interdisciplinaire Droit, entreprise et société of the Université Catholique de Louvain. He also teaches as a guest lecturer at the Université Saint-Louis de Bruxelles. He has been visiting Professor at the University "Robert Schumann" of Strasbourg (2001), at the University of Cassino (2002) and at the University of Milano (2008, 2009, 2010). He is a member of the ReMarkLab Group based at the Institute of Social Private Law of the University of Stockholm and of the Transnational Trade Union Rights Experts Network (TTUR). He has served as consultant for several projects directed and/or funded by the European institutions. He is permanent consultant of the European Trade Union Institute. In recent years he focused his research on sensitive themes such as the right to take collective action and the posting of workers, at the heart of the European debate after the case law of the CJEU, and on the jurisprudence of the Strasbourg Court of Human Rights. His most recent publications include The European Convention on Human Rights and the Employment Relation (2013) and Charte sociale européenne, droits sociaux et droits fondamentaux au travail (2016).
